Community Air Monitoring Program February 23, 2009 through March 1, 2009

Community air monitoring data is reviewed and compared to specific NYSDEC/NYSDOH approved criteria, known as "Action Limits". As a result of this evaluation process, site conditions are categorized into two categories, "Operational Condition" and "Action Condition". The "Operational Condition" is applicable when the data is below the "Action Limits" noted in the table below. The "Action Condition" occurs when one or more fifteen minute average measurement for Dust (PM₁₀), Total Volatile Organic Compounds (TVOC), Naphthalene or Odor Intensity exceeds the background or upwind measurement by the "Action Limits" in the table below. During the period from February 23, 2009 through March 1, 2009 there were six Fixed Air Monitoring (FAM) locations measuring Total Volatile Organic Compounds (TVOC) and Particulate Matter (PM₁₀). **Fifteen-minute averages for odor intensity, naphthalene, TVOC, and PM**₁₀ **data remained in Operational Condition**.
